Megan was diagnosed with Acute Myelogenous Leukemia in December 2006. She was treated at Hasbro Children's Hospital in Providence RI, receiving high dose chemotherapy. She did achieve remission, but unfortunately relapsed in July 2007 after her last dose of chemo. The next part of her journey involved a Bone Marrow Transplant, which she received at Floating Children's Hospital in Boston Mass. She received her sister Chelsea's precious marrow in September 2007. Meg's recovery went well, with few complications. We all thought we were nearing the end of this nightmare, until April 2008 when Megan relapsed once again. Megan fought her battle with the utmost strength, stamina, courage, and incredible positive attitude. Unfortunately, it just wasn't enough to win the fight against cancer. On June 5, 2008 at the age of 11, Megan lost her battle.

During the 18 months of Megan's journey, there were many amazing organizations that helped her keep a positive attitude in her fight.
